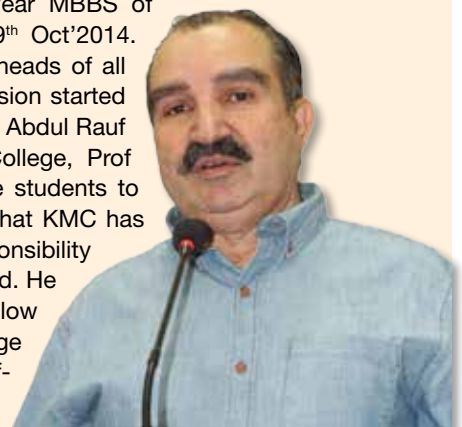


INTRODUCTORY LECTURE FOR 1st YEAR MBBS

This workshop was carried out in response to the needs identified worldwide and in Pakistan regarding the criminal justice system and the role of medico-legal

reports. The purpose of the workshop was to impart knowledge to the participants regarding proper examination of the victim (alive/ dead) and proper compilation of the medico-legal report in view of the changed medico-legal laws in the constitution of Pakistan.

It was a 3 day workshop which was attended by around 30 medico legal officers. They were given lectures regarding different important aspects of medico legal reporting by experts in the field, under the guidance of Dr Hakim Khan Afridi, Head Department of Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, KMC. 1. Nimra Zafar

Toledo student exchange program started when I was in 4th Year MBBS. I had the distinction to be amongst the three students who got selected by the selection committee to visit Toledo under the student exchange program. I had the honour to be the first student in history of KMC to do the observership/internship under the program.

After a detailed paperwork and constant support of our Principal, Prof Dr Ejaz Hassan Khan and Prof Dr Amjad Hussain, I managed to secure two slots in surgery as a summer elective student. I reached Toledo on 5th July and was warmly welcomed the moment I stepped out of the plane.

My rotations started the next morning after a brief hospital tour. Thenceforth I was engulfed in an ever busy schedule of reporting at 8 am in the morning and leaving at around 5pm in the evening. During this time I worked under, Dr Zelenock and Dr Baskara in Vascular and General Surgery. I went through the surgical ICU rounds, floor patients and out patients. I also had the opportunity to observe complicated surgeries like Da Vinci technique for first rib extraction.

During the outpatient day, I presented the histories to my attending and took active part in case discussion. It was then when I realized that medicine is not just about knowledge and theoretical learning, infact ethics form a much integral part. The humility with which doctors treated patients was unbelievable, an ambiance of trust was maintained and patient privacy was much emphasized upon.

Throughout my rotations, I attended conferences presided by chief of surgery and a multidisciplinary team comprising of consultant surgeons, physicians and medical students.

It won't be exaggeration to say it was an experience of lifetime. A glimpse into modern medicine and patient care was an eye opener. I hope to apply all I gained from my experience into practice and thrive to become a better doctor and a better human being.

In summer 2014 from 1st August to 12th September, I had the chance to do observership at the University of Toledo, Ohio as a part of the Student Exchange Program between KMC and University of Toledo. With the kind support of our Principal Prof Dr. Ejaz Hassan Khan, I visited the United States and availed the golden opportunity of working in a state-of-the-art facility like the aforementioned.

I was fortunate to get clinical attachments in the Emergency Medicine rotation led by Dr. Grider and the Gastroenterology rotation with Dr. Sode-man. To say the least, my experience was absolutely thriving and rewarding. I not only had a wonderful exposure to an excellent academia, but also happened to see for myself the advancement been made in the field of health research and education in the States. Over my six weeks of work in the rotations, I found each moment more productive than the other and a learning opportunity like no other.

I understand that if collaborations like these continue, we will be able to improve our current patient care structure and enable our students to acquire quality standard learning.

Last but not least, I extend my gratitude to our Principal and college administration and the staff at University of Toledo, Ohio for giving us this chance and supporting us throughout. Hoping to see it continue in the future.

On my arrival in Toledo, our adviser warmly greeted us with the smiling face and the same warmth with which my professors at KMC saw me off. During my tenure at University of Toledo Medical Center from August 4th through September 12th, 2014 I was housed in the Department of Surgery under the supervision of Dr. Gerald Zelenock. I worked with Dr. Thomas Schwann in the Cardiothoracic Department, Dr. Nazal in Vascular Surgery and Dr. Tang in General Surgery. I and other students of University of Toledo used to go on round in the morning, where the doctors explained to us the history taking and all the procedures underwent by the patients. Often they would ask few questions regarding the diseases. There were surgeries scheduled for everyday which were performed after the morning round. We used to go to operation theatre to help the doctors during the surgical procedure. After surgeries we would attend OPD where we would study the patient's history and then briefly present them to the attending doctor. There was a proper system for everything. Every information of the patients was stored in the computers, where there new Results were uploaded regularly.

The operation theatre was equipped with high tech machines. I even saw Da Vinci surgery which is a robotic surgery with dexterous hands.

The days I spent at University Of Toledo were the most precious days where I learned a lot and all these days passed in a blink of an eye.

Hepatitis Awareness Campaign

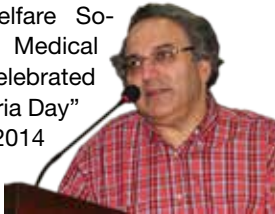
